

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

And

The HHI Kolkata

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is starting from 1st January 2023 and sets for the terms and understanding between Young Indians and The HHI Kolkata as mentioned in this MOU.

Introduction of Partners

Young Indians (Yi) is an integral part of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), a nongovernment, not-for-profit, industry led and industry managed organisation playing a proactive role in India's development process.

Yi was formed in the year 2002 with an objective of creating a platform for Young Indians to realize the dream of a developed nation. Yi has around 2800 direct members in 44 chapters, and engages around 18000 students through the brand 'YUVA'. The Yi membership includes young progressive Indians between the age group of 21 & 40 and comprises entrepreneurs, professionals and achievers from different walks of life. "To become the Voice of Young Indians Globally" being the vision of Yi, it provides a platform for young Indians to participate in and contribute by becoming an integral part of the Indian growth story. This MOU is not a legally binding document' and serves only as a guideline of the terms of engagement mutually agreed to between the said partners. The said MOU shall in no form be legally enforceable and has no binding on either party/partner involved in the same.



